A BILL

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Saudi Fugitive Declas-
3 sification Act of 2019”.

4 **SEC. 2. DECLASSIFICATION OF ANY AND ALL INFORMATION**
5 **RELATING TO ACTIONS BY GOVERNMENT OF**
6 **SAUDI ARABIA TO ASSIST PERSONS IN DE-**
7 **PARTING UNITED STATES WHO WERE AWAIT-**
8 **ING TRIAL OR SENTENCING IN UNITED**
9 **STATES.**

10 Not later than 30 days after the date of the enact-
11 ment of this Act, the Director of the Federal Bureau of
12 Investigation, in coordination with the Director of Na-
13 tional Intelligence, shall declassify any and all information
14 related to whether the government of Saudi Arabia materi-
15 ally assisted or facilitated any citizen or national of Saudi
16 Arabia in departing from the United States while the cit-
17 izen or national was awaiting trial or sentencing for a
18 criminal offense committed in the United States.
