2 **SEC. 606. RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.**

3 Nothing in this Act may be construed as authorizing  
4 the President to enter the United States into a treaty or  
5 binding international agreement on cybersecurity unless  
6 such treaty or agreement is approved with the advice and  
7 consent of the Senate pursuant to Article II, section 2,  
8 clause 2 of the Constitution.
